

# *NEW MOTORCYCLE LAW EFFECTIVE IN IDAHO JULY 1, 2006!*

***Senate Bill 1367***, which was passed by the Idaho Legislature and signed by Governor Kempthorne into law, addresses the problem motorcyclists have had with stoplight signalization for many years. The new law states in part that:

"...the driver of a motorcycle approaching an intersection that is controlled by a triggered traffic-control signal using a vehicle detection device that is inoperative due to the size of the motorcycle, shall come to a full and complete stop at the intersection. If the signal fails to operate after one cycle of the traffic signal, the driver may proceed after exercising due caution and care..."

*Section 49-802, Idaho Code*
